Mr. Siandou Fofana, the Minister of Tourism Côte d'Ivoire, is hosting an international roundtable in Hamburg (Germany) the 15th of November 2019 at the exclusive Fairmont Hotel Vier Jahreszeiten to promote the Ivorian Government's strategic plan for tourism by 2025 «*Sublime Côte d'Ivoire*». The Minister will present the investment opportunities of the sector tourisme with the objective of signing MoUs between the Minister of Tourism and international partners.

Seeing strong potential in the country's natural beauty, culture of hospitality and demographic youth bulge, the Ivorian government has chosen tourism as one of its priority sectors. With good weather, 520 kilometers of coastline, a diversified cuisine, vibrant culture, national parks and four UNESCO World Heritage Sites, Côte d'Ivoire has a lot to offer tourists from all over the world. Côte d'Ivoire, currently holding the 12th place for the best tourist destinations in Africa, is aiming to get to the 5th place, by 2025.

This roundtable welcomes decision-makers from the private and public sector. This includes, but is not limited to, c-level executives, investment funds, international organization and corporations, hotel groups, aviation companies, chambers of commerce and travel agencies.

Mr. Siandou Fofana, Minister of Tourism, has developed together with McKinsey & Company the ambitious strategic plan "Sublime Côte d'Ivoire" to increase economic and social development and to profile Côte d'Ivoire as a top destination in Africa by 2025.

The general strategy is cross-sectoral and demands inputs and expertise from sectors ranging from infrastructure, construction and energy to sports & leisure management, hotel management and education.

As part of the strategy the government formulated nine reforms and priorities projects. The projects are diverse in content, location and cost but all contribute to the goal of attracting more tourists, both domestic and international, while respecting the environment, promoting job creation, sustainable materials and construction and honoring the Ivorian culture.

The projects of €4,9 BN will be financed primarily through two funds. The first fund of €762 M is to be funded and managed by private investors. The second fund of €3,8 BN is a sovereign fund to act as a guaranty of state. All the priority projects have government guaranty (garantie d'état) and concession Public-Private-Partnerships. Sublime Côte d'Ivoire presents a unique opportunity for private companies and investors to gain access to the Ivorian market.

The tourism sector is experiencing a strong growth in Côte d'Ivoire since the end of the political crisis. In 2012, the tourism sector covered 2,4% of the total GDP, doubling to 5,5% in 2016. As part of realizing the strategy, the tourism sector is expected to cover 7-8% of total GDP by 2025. Additionally, the government wants to create 600,000 jobs in the tourism sector as well as welcome four million tourists annually.

Previous investments in hotel (2012-2018) include Sofitel Abidjan Ivoire hotel, Pullman Hotel, Ibis Plateau and Marcory, Azalai Hotel and Radisson Blue Abidjan. Future investments (2018-2025) include Sheraton Five Star Hotel, Mövenpick Hotel, Novotel, Adagio, Ritz-Carlton, Four Seasons and a luxury marina between Plateau and Cocody.

Originally from Agnibilékrou, in the East of Côte d'Ivoire, Mr. Siandou Fofana studied in Daoukro, then in France, where he obtained a PhD in International Finance and a postgraduate degree in Business Engineering and International Trade at the Institut supérieur de Commerce de Paris. He furthermore holds a degree in Financial Studies and Accountants at the Institut National des Techniques économiques et Comptables de Paris.

Mr. Siandou Fofana has several years of experience in the areas of road infrastructure development, and was in September 2009 appointed General Manager of the Road Maintenance Fund (FER). In 2017, he was appointed as Minister of Tourism and Leisure in Côte d'Ivoire.

Achievements and progress regarding Sublime Côte d'Ivoire since 2018

Commitments and agreements between the Minister of Tourism Côte d'Ivoire, private companies and International institutional institutions since the launch of the Program Sublime Côte d'Ivoire.

- Bilateral agreement signed between Portugal and Côte d'Ivoire in June 2019 on Tourism Training
- Bilateral agreement signed between Spain and Côte d'Ivoire in January 2019 which includes investments, shared knowledge, technical assistance and promotion of both countries' tourism sectors
- During the Madrid-Summit between Mr. Siandou Fofana and UNWTO, the Minister presented his strategy Côte d'Ivoire and received support from the United Nations agencies present
- Abidjan will be the headquarter of UNWTO's new programme: "Invest in Tourism in Africa" with its first international forum set to be in Abidjan, Oct 20-22 2020
- Lyon International Business School will open a branch, with a focus on tourism management and training.
- The Minister of Tourism has obtained support for the strategy of "Sublime Côte d'Ivoire" from African Development Bank, World Bank, European Union and International Monetary Fund
- Cooperation between Israel and the Ministry of Tourism on education, park development and ecotourism.
- MoU with Canadian Company Vertendre with the intend of building eco-lodges.
- Following the 23rd General Assembly of the World Tourism Organization in St. Petersburg, Russia, Côte d'Ivoire has been designated as member of the Executive Council by consensus and unanimously for the 2019-2023 term. Côte d'Ivoire will additionally host the World Tourism Day in 2021.
